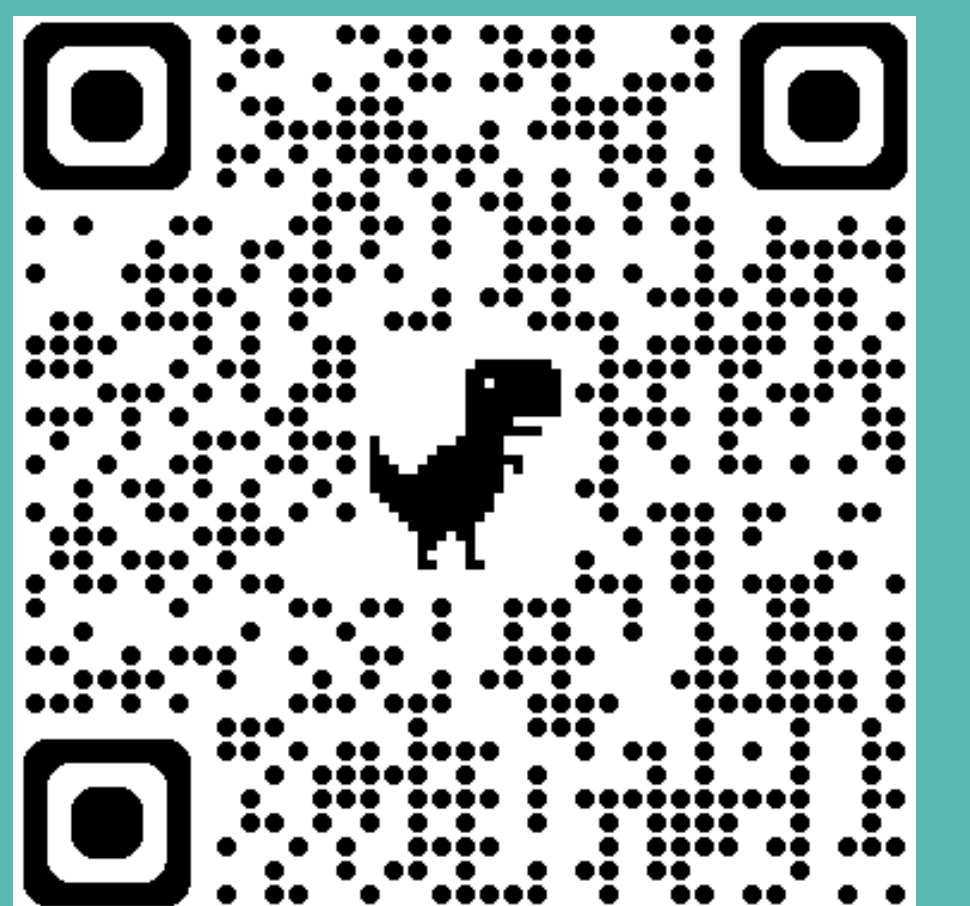


EMPLOYMENT PATHWAYS IN CANADA - HEALTH CAREERS



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PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The project supports **Internationally Educated Health Professionals (IEHPs)** in finding healthcare-related employment and developing career pathways while completing their **accreditation** and **licensing** process in Canada, with a focus on **nurses, pharmacists, and lab technicians**.

ELIGIBILITY

- Permanent Resident, or Canadian Citizen
- Healthcare experience and related degree/diploma from home country
- Legally eligible to work in Canada
- Open to relocation in rural Ontario or Alberta
- CLB level 7 or higher

- Two weeks of **online employment training**
- **Pre-employment** workshops, job coaching and matching support
- **Wraparound supports** and community **referrals** through Achēv
